



BASE ACCESS FAQ - DOMESTIC VISITORS

If I do not have a DoD ID (CAC or TESLIN), but have a DBIDS base access pass from the Visitors Control Center (VCC), can I have other people in the car with me?

Yes, as long as they have also picked up a DBIDS pass from the VCC.

If I have a DoD ID (CAC or TESLIN), can I have other people in the car with me?

Yes, as part of the DoD Trusted Traveler Program, you can vouch for up to 5 others who do not have DoD ID or a DBIDS Pass, but are in possession of one of the following acceptable forms of ID:

- Federal PIV Cards – DHS, FBI, DEA, State Department, etc.
- Personal Identity Verification Interoperable (PIV-I) Cards
- Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC)
- Defense Biometric Identification System (DBIDS) Card from another military installation.
- REAL ID or Enhanced ID
- Passport
- Federal ID

What if I have previously had a DBIDS pass to access MCB Quantico?

You should be able to enter your Social Security Number at the VCC and get verified on the pre-registered MDM list.

What type of information will I need to provide in the DBIDS enrollment process?

Any information not provided in the demographic information section will be asked at the VCC upon check-in.

Who should I list as my Sponsor?

You can list Alexander Hetherington, the MDM Show Director. His email is alexander.hetherington@emeraldx.com.

You could also use a co-worker if they have a **DoD ID (CAC or TESLIN)** that permits access to MCB Quantico.

What will I be required to have with me at the VCC?

You need to bring the following:

- QR code and/or the alpha-numeric code provided at the completion of your DBIDS application
- Completed SECNAV 5512 [form](#). If not completed prior to arrival you will be required to complete it in the waiting area before getting a base pass
- Modern Day Marine proof of registration form or cell phone screenshot
- ID
- A smile for your picture

Will I need a DBIDS pass if I park at the National Museum of the Marine Corps and utilize the shuttle?

Yes, we will have a team member checking that all riders of the shuttle either have a DBIDS pass obtained from the Quantico VCC, as well as one of the corroborating forms of ID listed above, or a DoD ID (CAC or TESLIN).

If I'm a non-DoD ID holder, what materials will I be required to show at the gate for base access?

You will need to provide a DBIDS Pass, obtained from the Quantico Visitor's Control Center (VCC), as well as one of the following forms of ID:

- Federal PIV Cards – DHS, FBI, DEA, State Department, etc.
- Personal Identity Verification Interoperable (PIV-I) Cards
- Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC)
- Defense Biometric Identification System (DBIDS) Card from another military installation.
- REAL ID or Enhanced ID
- Passport
- Federal ID

What would prevent me from getting a pass from the VCC?

Here are the primary disqualifications for base access. You can visit the Quantico Base Access page for complete information on grounds for restriction from base access [here](#).

- Any felony conviction
- Any warrants for arrest
- The VCC is unable to verify identity through a valid and acceptable form of ID
- Individual's name appears on a federal or state agency watch list
- Individual has been barred from access to a Marine Corps site, other DoD installations or facilities, or other federal site or facility
