- David Sienicki is a retired Naval Officer and has completed a number of diverse naval assignments including qualifications as a Surface Warfare Officer, Civil Engineer Corps Officer and a Department of Defense Acquisition Official.
- In 2001, David Sienicki received a legislative fellowship in Representative Taylor’s staff as the Military and Environmental Legislative Assistant. He returned to the Pentagon and served on the Chief of Naval Operations’ staff and served on the Secretary of the Navy’s staff as an Executive Assistant to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy.
